

IAGE Outstanding Researcher Award

The IAGE **Outstanding Researcher Award** recognizes outstanding scientific work in green energy research by a world-leading scientist or engineer. The award recipient must have demonstrated exceptional contribution to the green energy research community.

Rules and Eligibility

- Nomination is required. Self-nominations are not accepted.
- Nominees of any nationality are eligible.
- A nominee must be a well-recognized researcher who has contributed in an outstanding and innovative way to the progress of green energy research.
- Previous recipients of the Outstanding Researcher Award are not eligible.

Administration

- The Outstanding Researcher Award is managed by the IAGE Honors and Awards Committee.
- The IAGE Honors and Awards Committee is responsible for soliciting and evaluating nominations and making selection decisions.
- The Award is normally presented at the annual IGEC conference.

Nomination Submission Information

The nomination should be submitted to the IAGE Honors and Awards Committee. The nomination information required includes:

- Nominee and Nominator Information: Full name, organization, mailing address, email address, and telephone number.
- Nominator statement (2 pages maximum) which supports the candidate's suitability for the Award about the candidate's research work as a leader in green energy research.
- Curriculum vitae of the Nominee, a list of key publications, and any additional supporting information relevant to the Nominee's contribution may also be included.
- Two additional letters of support from established scientists or engineers familiar with the nominee's area(s) of research.
