About the conference

The International Green Energy Conference (IGEC) is a multi-disciplinary international conference on the use of energy with no or reduced environmental impacts and will provide a forum for the exchange of the latest technical information, for the dissemination of high-quality research results, for the presentation of new developments in the areas of energy and environment, and for the debate and shaping of future directions and priorities in sustainable development and energy security.
